Remote Learning Plan

Ambergate Primary School has developed the following remote learning plan. A survey has been carried out to ensure knowledge of each household's circumstances so appropriate support is given.

This plan will be applied in the following instances:

1. An individual is self-isolating due to waiting for test results or because of a positive test within the household;
2. A whole bubble or cohort is self-isolating because of an outbreak of coronavirus

Curriculum

Teachers will provide appropriate work in line with our current curriculum. Children will remain in contact with their Class teacher through MS Teams and Class Dojo.

White Rose Maths resources are currently used for the Maths curriculum across school. Children are very used using these resources on a daily basis. TT Rockstars and Numberbots will also be used to support the retention of number skills.

Oak Academy lessons will be used as appropriate.

MS Teams will support school in offering true online learning with the opportunity for the children to communicate with their teacher. The assignment tool will be used for children to receive work before submitting the task back to the class teacher so that feedback can be given.

Class Dojo will remain in use as the communication element has already proved to be invaluable. Teachers and parents continue to be able to message one another to share information and offer support. The Class Story page will offer the chance for teachers to celebrate children's work and maintain our school community.

Remote Learning

In the case of whole cohort isolation, resources will be uploaded to Class Dojo on the first day and priority children will have packs delivered and/or a laptop on loan from school. This will provide teachers with a short time to prepare their remote learning resources.

For individuals isolating and waiting for a test

- The lessons, resources and links for the day will be uploaded onto Class Dojo.
- Class Teacher will direct message the parent via Class Dojo to give supporting advice.
- Class Teacher will check in at the end of the school day to review progress.
- Class Teacher will phone the family to check in if the child does not engage or experiences difficulties.

If your child or household member then tests positive and they need to isolate

- The lessons, resources and links for the day will be uploaded onto Class Dojo.
- Class Teacher will direct message the parent via Class Dojo to give supporting advice.
- Class Teacher will check in at the end of the school day to review progress.
- Class Teacher will phone the family to check in if the child does not engage or experiences difficulties.
- Class Teacher will phone the family at least once a week.

For class bubbles isolating due to closure of their bubble/local lockdown

- All children have a Teams log in giving them access to the full Office suite.
- Class Teacher will arrange a Teams meeting with the families to discuss the organisation and expectations during this period. Timetabling will be monitored as some households have multiple children using the same device.
- Work will be uploaded every day following our current curriculum plan using the assignment tool.
- Tasks will be submitted back to the class teacher for feedback as appropriate.
- At least one recorded lesson will be available each day.
- One recorded reading session will take place each day.
- Assemblies will be scheduled and delivered by Mrs Howell.

Safeguarding/SEN/FSM

The Designated Safeguarding Lead (Mrs Howell) or Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead (Mrs Turner) will ensure the appropriate agencies are notified and regular checks are made for any vulnerable children who are isolating.

Mrs Howell will ring any families whose children are not engaging with remote learning in order to offer support as needed.

If any children are entitled to FSM, Mrs Howell or Mrs Horsman will contact the family to offer food packages.

Children who normally receive support from other agencies such as SSSEN, will continue to do so through Teams or resources uploaded to Class Dojo.
